Certificate in Sustainability for Finance

“Accountants and finance professionals have an important part to play, helping organisations adapt to the sustainable practices required to prevent resource depletion, facilitate long term success, and build a more sustainable future.”

Given the economic, regulatory and climate changes raising the importance of sustainability, in general, and in the accounting profession, in particular, the Faculty of Accounting and Management Information Systems from the Bucharest University of Economic Studies (CIG) and the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) partner to offer students a fast access to the ACCA [Certificate in Sustainability for Finance](#).

Students targeted: 3rd year bachelor students and master students, with a B2 (independent user) level in English. No prior knowledge of sustainability issues is required.

Period of time of the program: 6 weeks in the period 20 March – 10 May 2023

Time needed per week: approx. 4 hours (of which about one hour revision and mentoring with a CIG professor)

Cost: approx. 150 GBP

ACCA is offering: access to online materials; discounts for this program (the cost for individual purchases is 255 GBP); final assessment (and certificate)

CIG is offering: discounts for the cost of the program and an efficient system to obtain the certificate, including a mentoring (online) program to facilitate the overall understanding of the material and a schedule motivating students to complete on time. The mentors are Professor Mădălina Dumitru and Professor Voicu Dragomir, with a vast experience in teaching and doing research on sustainability related topics.
